**A RESOLUTION OF DUBLIN BOROUGH, BUCKS COUNTY, RATIFYING AND REPORTING CONTRACTS
MADE FOR THE PURPOSE OF EMERGENCY MAINTENANCE, REPAIRS OR REPLACEMENTS TO
WATER, ELECTRICITY OR PUBLIC WORKS FACILITIES**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Pennsylvania Borough Code, at 8 Pa.C.S.A. § 1402 (d), Borough Council is authorized to contract for emergency maintenance, repairs or replacements to water, electricity or public works facilities without advertised bids; and

WHEREAS, on the morning of August 2, 2024 the pump at Well # 5 experienced an operational failure resulting in the inability to supply water to the Borough's water system; and

WHEREAS, due to the urgent nature of inability to supply water from Well #5, it is necessary to immediately secure contractors and/or supplies for the emergency maintenance, repairs or replacements to the water facility without advertised bids, and the Borough Council now desires to ratify such determination.

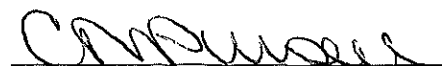
NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Dublin Borough Council, Bucks County, Pennsylvania hereby resolves as follows:

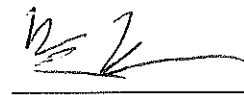
1. The Borough entered into an agreement with Raab Well Drilling, Inc., for emergency work for consideration in the amount of \$15,855.00.
2. The emergency that necessitated the procurement of said contract was the operational failure of the pump at Well #5 which is located in the rear of the property of 161 N. Main Street known as the Dublin Shopping Center.
3. The Borough procured the emergency maintenance, repairs or replacement with Raab Well Drilling, Inc., a contractor who is familiar with the Borough's water system and is available in a reasonable time frame to complete the repair.
4. The emergency maintenance, repairs or replacements do not constitute new additions, extensions or enlargements of existing facilities and equipment.
